Misuse of a locker may result in the termination of locker privilege.

- Lockers are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- You must provide your own lock.
- Lockers are semester-base usage only.
 At the end of each semester, you must clear out all contents of your locker. Failure to do so, will result in the cutting of your lock and the discarding of its contents.
- No food/beverages, hazardous, or illegal material may be stored in the lockers.
- Students are not permitted to affix anything to the interior or exterior of the lockers.
- Lockers should be used to store school/teaching supplies and personal items necessary for use at the univeristy.
- You are soley responsible for the contents of the locker.

The Department assumes no responsibility for loss, damage, or theft of any item(s) in a locker; locked or unlocked.

- You must keep your locker in good condition.
- There is a fee for damaged lockers. It is the cost to repair the lockers plus \$25. Students are held responsible to report any damage or needed repairs to the Staff.
